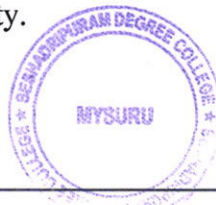
Institutional Strength

Strengths:

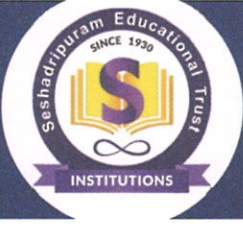
- Legacy of 92 years into teaching founded by two women. Conventional Education of 9 decades of teaching tradition transformed into a robust institutional culture.
